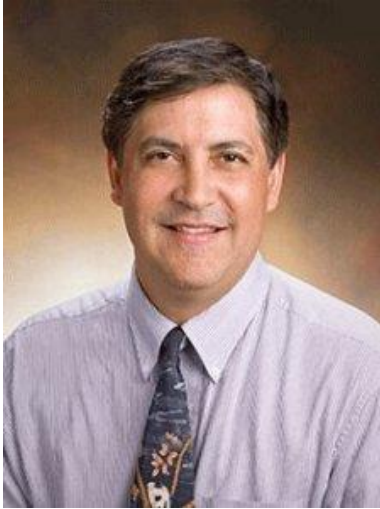

Wolfgang Aulitzky, MD is the Medical Director of the American Austrian Foundation. He is Associate Dean for International Medicine and Distance Learning, Adjunct Prof. of Clinical Urology and Adjunct Prof. of Clinical Reproductive Medicine at the Weill Medical College of Cornell University/New York Presbyterian Hospital. In 2016, he was appointed Adjunct Professor of Pediatrics in the Associated Faculty of the Perelman School of Medicine at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. He is also Associate Prof. of Urology at the Medical University of Innsbruck and Visiting Professor at the Medical University of Vienna. Amongst others he is a member of the American, German and Austrian Societies of Urology and was awarded the Zuckermandpreis of the Austrian Society of Urology in 1989. In 1995 he received the Silver Medal, in 2007 the Golden Medal for Merits to the Republic of Austria and in 2014 the cross of honor of the Land Salzburg. As Director of the Medical Program of the American Austrian Foundation he has initiated the Open Medical Institute, a scientific and educational collaboration of Weill Cornell and the NewYork Presbyterian Hospital, the Children Hospital of Philadelphia, Duke University, Columbia University, the Cleveland Clinic and leading hospitals in Austria. Dr. Aulitzky earned his medical degree at the University of Innsbruck in 1977, was a research associate at the University of Uppsala, Sweden and the Rockefeller University, New York. He received his training as an urologist at the University of Innsbruck and the General Hospital of Salzburg. He is the author of more than 140 publications on Urology, Andrology and Health Care issues and is co-author of books on basic and clinical urology/andrology.

James Guevara, MD, MPH is a general pediatrician and health services researcher. Dr. Guevara grew up in San Jose, California and completed his undergraduate studies at the University of California in Davis, California. He graduated from Northwestern University Medical School in Chicago, Illinois and completed his pediatrics residency and general academic pediatrics fellowship at the University of Washington, in Seattle, Washington. During his fellowship, he studied health services research and completed an MPH degree. He is currently Professor of Pediatrics & Epidemiology at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania and an attending physician at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. His current areas of research are in inequities in early child development and behavioral problems. He is currently conducting two clinical trials on the effects of patient navigation for children with developmental disabilities and social media-based parent coaching for postpartum depression. He is a standing member of the Healthcare and Health Disparities (HHD) Study Section at the National Institutes of Health, an Executive Committee member of the American Academy of Pediatrics Council on Early Childhood, and an Associate Editor of the peer-review journal *Academic Pediatrics*. He lives in Moorestown, New Jersey with his wife Cindy and has two boys Christopher and Nathaniel.

Dr. Hogan grew up in the midwestern United States in the state of Ohio and completed her undergraduate studies at John Carroll University in University Heights, Ohio. She graduated from the University of Toledo College of Medicine and Life Sciences, formerly the Medical College of Ohio, and completed her pediatric residency at The Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia. Dr. Hogan is an Assistant Professor of Clinical Pediatrics at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania and an attending physician in the Division of General Pediatrics at The Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia.
