He is a peer reviewer for several journals in his fields of expertise, and he recently completed a term on the Board of Directors for the Society for Pediatric Anesthesia. Aaron G. DeWitt, MD is a pediatric cardiologist who specializes in the critical care of neonates and children with congenital and acquired heart disease and adults with congenital heart disease. Dr. DeWitt grew up in Hudson River Valley of Upstate New York. He completed his undergraduate studies at Dartmouth College in Hanover, New Hampshire before returning to his home state of New York to attend medical school at the University of Rochester in Rochester, NY. After graduating, he remained in Rochester, NY for his internship, residency, and chief residency in pediatrics. Finally, his training took him to Ann Arbor, Michigan for pediatric cardiology fellowship following which he was the Samara Mendu fellow in cardiac critical care. 
